

Ministerio Manantial

Ministerio Manantial is a safe place for low-income families and street children. They desire to provide their children healthy food and a solid education. In 2022, they were able to feed 100 children and 50 adults and distributed food bags to low-income families from their community within Guadalajara, Mexico each Saturday. They also finished their building's concrete floor. Previously the building only had a dirt floor, and this year they also developed a Literacy Program to help school-aged children who did not know how to read or write.

Their passion is to help their community in need. The following summarizes what our contributions helped us them do in 2022.

- In January, they traveled to "Mosquitia Hondurena," one of Hondura's poorest states. They distributed 500 toys and school supplies to low-income children.
- They assisted two families with school supplies and food in February.
- March through June, they assisted a family with four children who used to work in a metal factory. The mother had a stroke, and the children were in dire financial need. El Shaddai provided food for the family. They also used part of our donations to rescue a 13-year-old girl who a human trafficking group kidnaped. They assisted the mother in finding the girl, hiding her from the group, and transporting her safely back to their community.
- In July, they traveled to Nicaragua and Costa Rica to bless local churches with Sunday school supplies for their children.
- From August to September, they bless the children of three different communities with toys and bibles.
- In October and November, they worked with churches in areas of extreme need from three states in Honduras and blessed them with toys, bibles, and Sunday school supplies.

This year they were limited by some short periods of Covid-19 lockdown and missionary illness. Despite the circumstances, they are proud of what they have achieved for the Kingdom with their partners' faithful and generous help and the grace of God working with them.

JAKARTA MINISTRY

These groups do not have the means to attend a church service, so they feel blessed by their ministry. Commisioned2Go conducted four outreaches at the stroke Rehab, two outreaches at leper village, one outreach to the homeless in 5 different locations, two outreaches for our handicapped ministry, and distributed food gifts to the poor on the streets during Ramadan. They also continued supporting the lepers with \$180 monthly for food supplies and got to preach twice to the adults.

EAST NUSA TENGGARA (NTT)

East Nusa Tenggara is a group of islands far from Jakarta and Borneo. It is one of the poorest regions of Indonesia. Some villages live primarily on corn. Although this is not one of their regions for ministry, they sent Frits one of their missionaries to work there during this Covid pandemic, as he is a native of this region. While there, he worked with the local school as a tutor, offered a Bible program, and helped with Sunday school in the village church. They also purchased cupboards, tables, lamps, fans, and other supplies for the reading ministry, and they helped a college student of a Tribal pastor with tuition fees.

KIUNG VILLAGE

They were in this Village for four weeks. During that time, they offered Sunday school, had three youth services, 44 home visitations, offered seven training courses for kid's workers, did one kid's crusade, led three cell groups, and had one farewell church service.

SABU ISLAND

Their ministry in Sabu Island lasted eight weeks. They taught children every day in the Inspiration Reading room, had the opportunity to run Sunday school and youth services, and preached in the local churches. They also did home visitation, had a community children's crusade, trained Sunday school workers, and distributed food every Thursday for the children and their families.

MALAKA

Their workers only stayed in Malaya ten days, but during those days, they were able to do two youth services, offered Sunday school twice, did one cell group, and had four training sessions for children's workers.

BERINGIN VILLAGE

They stayed in the village for almost three months. In that time, they did Sunday schools, youth services, four church services, five cell groups, forty home visitations, two children's workers trainings, and twelve tutorials for Junior School workers.

BORNEO MISSIONARY TEAM

The ministry is based in Borneo. Therefore, their work here is ongoing. This year they worked with the nursing home and the orphanage, ministered to the students at the Baptist Theological College, worked with the house of hope, and continued with their adult church services.

In most villages in Borneo their teams go to, the Christian churches have tiny congregations, sometimes less than five families, no pastor, and no Sunday school. In many villages, they start a Sunday school and train Sunday school teachers, start a reading program for children, a youth and cell group, and lead church services. They sometimes hold crusades and visit homes bringing many to Christ, healing the sick, and helping those in need of emotional healing.

JAKARTA

In Jakarta, they typically run a service, which includes praise and worship, short preaching, a call to salvation, puppet or drama, and games. Often this is followed by individual prayer and spending time with people. Snacks and a full meal are given as well as donations of basic food supplies they call "sembako" like rice, oil, sugar, salt, coffee, and flour.


